



**Call for Papers for the *Política Internacional Academic Journal*
Issue No. 139 (2026-I)**

“Peru–United States: Two Hundred Years of Bilateral Relations”

The Diplomatic Academy of Peru “Javier Pérez de Cuéllar” (ADP) cordially invites active and retired diplomatic officials, national and international scholars and specialists, as well as postgraduate students, to submit articles for consideration for publication in Issue No. 139 (2026-I) of *Revista Política Internacional*.

The theme of this issue will be **“Peru–United States: Two Hundred Years of Bilateral Relations”**

This edition seeks to reflect on the historical development and evolution of bilateral relations between the two countries, from the early influence of the United States in the context of Peru’s independence and the shaping of the hemispheric order—including the Monroe Doctrine—to the major milestones that have defined relations between both States over two centuries.

Contributors are also invited to examine the various dimensions of contemporary bilateral cooperation, particularly in the political, institutional, and security spheres, including efforts to prevent and combat drug trafficking and transnational organized crime, as well as trade, investment, and economic development, taking into account the impact of the Peru–United States Free Trade Agreement and opportunities for sustainable cooperation.

Within today’s international context—marked by the positions of the Trump administration and the emergence of new actors with growing influence on the global balance of power—authors are encouraged to reflect on the challenges and opportunities facing the Peru–United States relationship. In this regard, submissions are expected to analyze Peru’s role in this evolving landscape, the principles guiding its foreign policy, including its commitment to dialogue and active neutrality, as well as the challenges, perspectives, and opportunities shaping the future of bilateral relations as both countries move toward a third century of ties.

Submitted articles must be original, unpublished, and exclusive.

Submission Process and Requirements

1. Registration and Submission

Interested authors must register and log in to submit their articles through the journal's new online platform:

2. Article Guidelines

- Submissions must be in Microsoft Word format.
- The manuscript must NOT include any personal information about the author(s), to ensure anonymity.
- Abstracts in Spanish and English (maximum 200 words).
- Keywords in Spanish and English.
- Font: Arial, size 12.
- Line spacing: 1.5.
- References must follow APA (7th edition) guidelines.
- Bibliography at the end of the article.
- Maximum length (excluding bibliography): 5,500 words.

3. Authorship Contributions (for two or more authors)

Authors must specify their respective contributions to the submitted manuscript using the Contributor Roles Taxonomy (CRediT). These roles may be consulted at:

4. Anonymous Peer Review

All submissions will undergo anonymous peer review by subject-matter experts appointed by the ADP, who will assess the suitability of articles for publication. Only manuscripts that comply with the formal requirements outlined above will proceed to the review stage.

5. Revisions and Publication

Authors will be informed of the peer-review results through the platform. When reviewers recommend publication subject to revisions, authors must implement the requested changes in order for the article to be published in *Revista Política Internacional*.

6. Bilingual Publication (Spanish and English)

The journal is published in bilingual format. Authors of accepted articles will be asked to provide a translated version of their manuscript (which may be prepared using specialized software or digital tools such as Microsoft Word or similar). This version will be reviewed by the journal's copy editor prior to final publication.
