



**Call for Papers for the *Política Internacional Academic Journal*
*Issue No. 140 (2026-II)***

“Peru–Bolivia: Two Hundred Years of Bilateral Relations”

The Diplomatic Academy of Peru Javier Pérez de Cuéllar invites active and retired diplomats, academics, national and international experts, and postgraduate students to submit original manuscripts for publication consideration in Issue No. 140 (2026-II) of *Política Internacional*.

This issue, "Peru–Bolivia: 200 Years of Bilateral Relations," explores the historical development and evolution of the relationship between the two countries, rooted in a shared Andean heritage, deep cultural ties, and a common history that predates the establishment of their republics. Authors are invited to examine the key milestones that have shaped bilateral relations over the past two centuries, as well as the role of diplomacy, border integration, and people-to-people ties in fostering a relationship defined by geographic proximity and shared historical and cultural bonds.

Contributions are also encouraged on the contemporary dimensions of Peru-Bolivia cooperation, particularly border integration and the development of border communities, the joint management of the Lake Titicaca watershed, the protection of natural and cultural heritage, the preservation of Andean cultures and Indigenous peoples, and political, economic, commercial, and security cooperation, including efforts to combat drug trafficking, smuggling, and other forms of transnational organized crime.

Against the backdrop of profound geopolitical change, shared regional challenges, and emerging opportunities for South American integration, this issue also invites reflection on the future of Peru-Bolivia relations as they enter their third century of diplomatic ties. Authors are encouraged to explore the role of both countries in regional integration, sustainable development, the management of shared resources, strengthened border cooperation, and the advancement of a bilateral agenda that promotes the well-being of communities on both sides of the border.

All submissions must be original, unpublished, and must not be under consideration for publication elsewhere.

I. Submission Process

1. Submission Procedure

Authors must register and submit their manuscripts through the Política Internacional online submission system:

To begin, select "Submissions" and either log in to an existing account or create a new one.

II. Manuscript Guidelines

1. Manuscript Format

Submitted manuscripts must comply with the following requirements:

- Microsoft Word format.
- The manuscript must not contain any identifying information to ensure anonymous peer review.
- An abstract in Spanish and English (maximum 200 words).
- Keywords in Spanish and English.
- Arial, 12-point font.
- 1.5 line spacing.
- References formatted according to the APA 7th Edition guidelines.
- A complete bibliography at the end of the manuscript.
- A maximum length of 5,500 words, excluding references.

2. Authorship Contributions

For manuscripts with two or more authors, contributors must specify their respective roles using the CRediT (Contributor Roles Taxonomy).

3. Double-Blind Peer Review

All manuscripts that meet the journal's submission requirements will undergo double-blind peer review conducted by subject-matter experts appointed by the Diplomatic Academy of Peru. Only manuscripts that satisfy the journal's formatting and submission requirements will proceed to peer review.

4. Use of Artificial Intelligence

Authors may use Artificial Intelligence (AI) tools to support the preparation of their manuscripts, provided that such tools do not replace the author's intellectual contribution. AI-generated content must not exceed 20% of the submitted manuscript.

To ensure the quality, originality, and integrity of all published works, every submission will be screened using Turnitin or an equivalent platform to assess both textual similarity and the proportion of AI-generated content.

5. Revisions and Publication

Authors will be notified of the outcome of the peer-review process through the journal's online platform. When revisions are requested, authors must submit a revised version before the manuscript can be accepted for publication in *Política Internacional*.

6. Bilingual Publication

Política Internacional is published in Spanish and English. Authors of accepted manuscripts will be required to provide an English translation of their work. Translations may be prepared using professional translation software or AI-assisted tools; however, all translations will be reviewed by the journal's language editor prior to publication.

III. Submission Deadline and Contact Information
